MOD PODGE[®] SHEER COLORS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Can Sheer Colors be used outside?

No, Sheer Colors are not weatherproof and should not be used in outdoor applications.

Are Sheer Colors permanent?

No, Sheer Colors can be removed with warm water.

How are Sheer Colors applied?

Sheer Colors can be applied via the dripping method or with a brush or spouncer. Dripping will give you a smooth finish. Application with brushes or spouncers will add texture.

What is the dripping method for Sheer Colors?

Pour Sheer Colors into a jar. Swirl the color around. Turn jar upside down over a cup to collect excess paint. After the excess paint has dripped out, stand jar upright to dry. Dry time can take up to 24 hours or more. Trim excess paint from lid with craft knife.

Can Sheer Colors be used to paint wood?

Yes, brush Sheer Colors onto raw wood. Add several layers for darker colors.

What is the coverage area for a four ounce bottle of Sheer Colors?

Four ounces covers 2 square feet.

On which surfaces can Sheer Colors be used?

Sheer Colors can be used on glass, wood, metal and paper.

Can Sheer Colors be oven-cured?

No, Sheer Colors are not oven-safe and cannot be baked or oven-cured.

What are the minimum and maximum temperatures for using Sheer Colors?

Sheer Colors should only be used in temperatures above 45° F and no more than 80° F.

What is the drying time for Sheer Colors?

Allow at least eight hours for drying and 3-7 days for curing. Drying will also depend on humidity. Application via the dripping method can take up to 24 hours or longer to dry.

Can Sheer Colors be mixed to make new colors?

Yes, Sheer Colors can be mixed together to create new colors.

Are jars tinted with Sheer Colors safe to hold water?

That depends. Jars or vases painted on the inside with Sheer Colors cannot be used to hold water; however, jars with Sheer Colors applied to the outside of the jar or vase can.

Can Sheer Colors be used to color the inside of ornaments?

Yes, just drip paint inside and roll ornament until covered. Turn the ornament upside down in a cup to drain and dry.

How are Sheers Colors removed?

Remove Sheer Colors with warm water and a paint scraper.

Are Sheer Colors food-safe?

No. Although Sheer Colors are water-based and non-toxic, they are not approved for contact with food.

Are Sheer Colors heat-resistant?

No, Sheer Colors are not resistant to heat and should not be baked or used in areas subject extreme temperatures.

Can Sheer Colors be used in kitchen or bathroom decor?

No, Sheer Colors should not be used in areas subject to high humidity.

Can Sheer Colors be darkened?

To darken a color, apply another layer of Sheer Color after the first layer dries.

Can Sheer Colors be used on a light bulb?

Do not use a bulb brighter than 40 watts. Higher wattage may cause rapid fading.

Can glitter be used with Sheer Colors?

Yes, just apply a light cover of Sheer Color. Sprinkle glitter while color is wet. Let dry and wipe off excess glitter.

How are Sheer Colors cleaned up?

While the liquid is still wet, use soap and water.
